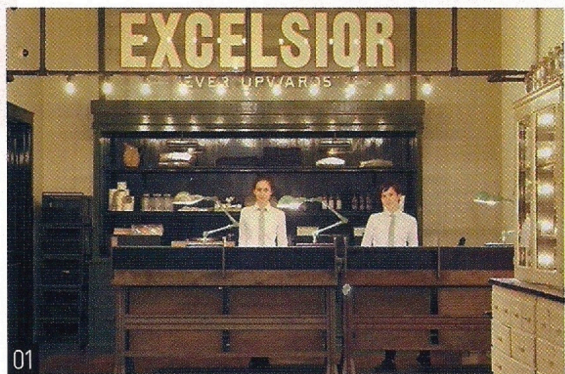
## BEAUTY FIX
